
STRUCTURE OF THE LANGUAGE OF THOUGHT

Romper (Break, Burst open, Come out, Rupture): To burst forth or sprout.

FIRST JUNCTION

Significant level of language. Language is assimilated as geometric. The laws governing the Void. Laws that are determined by rhythm.

Concept

Concepts that become visual to help comprehend the mechanisms of the language underlying all **constructs**.

Consciousness

Composition of a situation from which to have easy access to the spatial relations fostered by contemplated **matter**.

Matter that becomes consciousness and vice-versa.

The **Void** is where relationships develop between the elements, configuring other elements until the structure of a language is built up that identifies the meaning of the first stroke. Of the first element. Of the arc. Of the **Horizon**. Of the Human.
